



Productivity test of the rake

To scientifically demonstrate the commercial advantage of our rake structure, we have sampled

2000 hands (real) played from players on our network. To these same hands, we have then, by simulation, applied the structure of rake used from two competitors (Entraction and I poker), so as to trace the differences.

Before analysing the results of this simulation, we can describe the sample of the players (type of gamblers) taken in consideration.

Gambler samples and relevant game styles

Pc2-Veron

Gambler of 6 max, stakes of the 1/2 - 2/4 - 3/6:

Considered "closed" and "aggressive" given that the percentage of hands played are under 1-2% of the total hands played. From the registration records results as a loser, but with a high production of rake.

Uqp-BOOM2

Gambler that plays mainly the 6 max, but does not disregard the heads up, with stakes that go from 5/10 and 10/20:

Described as a "regular" gambler, this is a losing gambler, with one style considered "open" (loose) and "aggressive" given the high percentage of hands played. With this type of gambler more rake is produced as in the tables heads up, a lot of more hands are played than usual.

Apk-AleChiringuito

Stakes played: 10/20 and 5/10 - favorite tables: 6 max:

Classic example of "regular" gambler, defined as an expert, capable of multi-tablars and a winner in the long run. Winning at present and capable of beating the rake (that is producing more profit than the rake).

Being an expert, this gambler can adapt the game according to the type of opponent. (The oscillations of the rake alternate in moderate manner in the game hands, alternating high percentages to rather low percentages).

apk-Dado-1985

Gambler of low stakes (maximum 1/2):

This is a medium gambler, that prefers heads up and tables 4 max (halfway between heads up and 6 max). This is a very closed, non winning gambler that is too cautious, and resulting in a loss producing an equal rake or slightly superior to its debits.



Rake Test

Gambler of Hold' em and Omaha, absolute loser, "maniac" type, does not play to a fixed stake but varies between the 5/10 downwards, can occasionally risk the greatest stake, in this case 20/40. Plays mainly the 6max. Due to the style of the game, this type of gambler, produces little rake with respect to the limits that can be played, the maximum is lost in relatively few hands.

[Bxp-SclaPrunzWewe](#)

Gambler that prefers the 6 max: Very expert, capable of multi-tablare. Absolute winner, with medium stake played 5/10 and 10/20, considered as aggressive and loves the game to the preflop. Comparison rake/won 4:3

[Uqp-diablo50](#)

Occasional gambler, that plays on the 6/4/9 max to a stake that changes from 0,25/0.50 to 2/4. This is a loser gambler without a specialised defined game (pot limit, fixed limit and no limit) that does not succeed to produce profit. Can be defined as "Aggressive Loser"

[Unq-mike69](#)

Extreme loser gambler. Plays the micro levels till the middle stakes (1/2), prefers the 6 and 4 max. Even this gambler like the previous one does not have a specialised defined game and is considered a "regular" loser, the so-called "MANIAC" type (very loose aggressive).

Data shows that on Enet's network the same gamblers generate a greater rake of at least 40% with respect to the competitors.
